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SODA ASH IN APRIL 2009

U.S. natural soda ash production in April was 664,000 metric tons (t), 9% lower than the previous month's production of 732,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. The continued downturn in production was because of poor economic conditions affecting domestic and export sales.

Ending inventories for April 2009 were 239,000 t, 15% lower than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in April was 1,080,000 t. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in March 2009 was 397,000 t, 24% lower than that of March 2008, and ending stocks were 44% higher.

Exports and imports of soda ash in March 2009 were 329,000 t and 666 t, respectively.

The trends in soda ash statistics for March 2009, compared with those of March 2008, were as follows: production was 23% lower; imports were 45% lower; exports were 23% lower; and apparent consumption, 24% lower.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.
