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## DIRECTORY OF PRINCIPAL CONSTRUCTION AGGREGATES PRODUCERS IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2008

Production of 2.48 billion metric tons of construction aggregates valued at \$21.2 billion, free on board at plant, was reported in the United States in 2008 by 5,400 companies with more than 10,000 operations, 3,900 active quarries, and 7,800 active pits. These companies also reported sales of construction aggregates from 263 sales yards.

The 10 leading producing States were, in descending order of tonnage, Texas, California, Pennsylvania, Florida, Illinois, Missouri, Ohio, Arizona, New York, and Indiana, which accounted for 45% of the total output of construction aggregates.

The 10 companies listed in table 1 with a total of 936 active quarries and 690 active sand and gravel operations accounted for 35% of the total output and 38% of the total value of construction aggregates in the United States. In addition, these companies operated 214 sales/distribution yards. The companies listed in table 1 are not included in table 2 when the company is not a leading producer in a given State.

These 10 plants accounted for 3% of the total output of sand and gravel in the United States.

Companies listed in table 3 may not be listed among the principal producers for a particular State even though they may have a pit or quarry in that State.
