CEMENT IN JULY 2018

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers and the production of clinker in the United States from January 2017 through July 2018.¹ Data on the imports of cement and clinker for July 2018 also are provided. Listings of leading States (below) are in order of descending activity.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico in July 2018 were about 9.3 million metric tons (Mt), up by 9.4% from shipments in July 2017 (tables 2A and 2B). Shipments for the year through July totaled about 55.2 Mt, up by 3.8% from those for the same period in 2017. The leading producing States for portland and blended cement in July 2018 were Texas, Missouri, California, Florida, and Michigan (table 1A), and these accounted for about 40% of the country total. The leading cement-consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Ohio, and Illinois) received about 37% of the July shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Masonry cement shipments of about 228,000 metric tons in July 2018 were up by 12.9% from those in July 2017 (table 2C). For the year through July, shipments totaled 1.42 Mt, essentially unchanged from those for the same period in 2017. The leading masonry-cement-consuming States in July 2018 were Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia; these States received about 60% of the July shipments.

Clinker production totaled 7.3 Mt in July 2018, up slightly from the output (excluding Puerto Rico) in July 2017 (table 4). For the year through July 2018, production was about 43.0 Mt, slightly higher than that of the same period in 2017. The leading clinker-producing States in July 2017 were Texas, California, Missouri, Florida, and Pennsylvania, and these accounted for about 48% of the July output.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 list import data from the U.S. Census Bureau; however, data for clinker imports into the Seattle, WA, and the Detroit, MI, customs districts do not include material trucked in from Canada on an informal entry basis. Likewise, imports of cement into the El Paso, TX, district are missing significant informal entries from Mexico. Monthly imports can show significant year-over-year changes for a variety of reasons and commonly do not correlate well with consumption levels in the respective import districts in the same month. July 2018 imports of cement and clinker totaled about 1.6 Mt, up by 13.9% from imports in July 2017. Imports for January through July 2018 totaled 8.5 Mt, up by 10.5% from imports in the same period in 2017.
