PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN APRIL 2013

Engelhard's average April prices for platinum, palladium, and rhodium decreased by 6%, 7%, and 5%, respectively, compared with average March prices. The average monthly price for iridium decreased slightly and that for ruthenium remained unchanged during the same period. Prices for platinum, palladium, and rhodium decreased sharply at midmonth in response to a drop in the price of gold that was caused by heavy selling of gold. Platinum and palladium prices recovered slightly at monthend. Platinum prices were below those for gold in the beginning of the month, and then ranged from near parity to above those for gold in the middle and latter parts of the month.

Stillwater Mining Co.'s (Billings, MT) mines produced 3,950 kilograms (kg) of platinum and palladium during the first quarter of 2013, 4 % less than that in the previous quarter and 5% greater than that in the first quarter of 2012. Production included 2,220 kg of palladium and 663 kg of platinum from the Stillwater Mine and 834 kg of palladium and 239 kg of platinum from the East Boulder Mine. Stillwater planned to produce about 15,600 kg of platinum-group metals (PGMs) in 2013. Stillwater recovered a record-high 4,800 kg of platinum, palladium, and rhodium from recycled catalytic converters, 30% more than the amount recovered in the previous quarter owing to new suppliers as well as to higher PGM prices. Stillwater's three development projects remained on track. The 2,500-meter tunnel for the Graham Creek Project was expected to be finished in May 2013 and production was planned to begin in 2014, with production of 900 kilograms per year (kg/yr) of PGMs expected by 2015. The Far West project in the western end of the Stillwater Mine was expected to take about 3 years to complete; production of about 622 kg PGMs was expected in 2016 and about 1,200 kg/yr PGMs in subsequent years. Tunnel boring continued at the Blitz project, to the east of the existing Stillwater Mine. Blitz production was expected to replace gradually declining production from other areas in the Stillwater Mine and to contribute an additional 780 kg/yr of PGMs. No date was given for completion of the Blitz project (Stillwater Mining Co., 2013).

Unrest continued in the platinum mining sector in South Africa. Workers' strikes at Anglo American Platinum Ltd. (Amplats) mines resulted in lost production of about 310 kg of platinum during the first quarter of 2013 compared with production in the same quarter of 2012. Platinum production totaled 18,100 kg during the first quarter of 2013. Amplats projected 2013 annual production of 68,000 to 72,000 kg of platinum. Amplats continued talks with South Africa's Department of Natural Resources regarding previously announced plans to cut 14,000 jobs and to close four unprofitable shafts in the Rustenburg area. The plans were met with strenuous objections from workers' unions. Results were expected to be announced in May. A workers' strike also took place at Northam Platinum Ltd.'s Zondereinde Mine leading to a production loss of about 500 kg of PGMs (Anglo American Platinum Ltd., 2013a, b; Northam Platinum Ltd., 2013).
